The St-Alban's Hermitage

From the Place du Claux, walk along the old Market, cross the Place St-Jacques (you pass in front of the bakery), follow the track between the gardens, along the canal des Vernèdes. This is the point of departure for the GR 71 Tour du Larzac.

You see the orchard, further you will see the campsite Les Vernèdes. Then, you arrive on the road to the Durzon spring.



Go on this road until the bridge of St-Martin (the building on the left accommodated a copper mill, then a sawmill which burnt in June 1996, 30th).

Cross the bridge over the Durzon river (B) and follow the road. Now we can have a look at the chapel of St-Martin du Vican (priory united with the Benedictine Abbey of Nant until 1777. This parish chapel was closed down during the Revolution and then sold).



Follow on your right the little road which leads to Prat-Nau. Leave the buildings (private property)

and go on the dirt track which will leads you to the point (C), to the agricultural reserve. When you get to the point (D), go on until Le Liquier. Cross the hamlet and at the exit, turn left to the GR 71 path to arrive at the point (E).

1st choice:

Go down to Nant: the path will lead you to the road of Nant - St Jean du Bruel (F), nearby the petrol station Total. Go back to the Place du Claux.

2nd choice:

Go up to the St Alban's Hermitage (802m of altitude, as high as the Roc Nantais, face to it). You need one hour (to go up & return), 960m of sustained walk (difference in height: 200m).




